Financial report

A year to date statement of revenues and expenses was presented.

It was discussed that the Raffle Account should hold only the dollars relating to the playground fundraiser. As such, a deposit previously made to the general account (Sk. Lotteries) and a cheque written from the raffle account (yearbook/classroom allocations) should be adjusted. The raffle account was previously sitting at \$10,908. After these adjustments the Raffle account will be \$17,134.

Ané made motion to transfer the dollar amounts mentioned above, seconded by Tricia.

Other Comments/Business
